

Group Greek Lessons for Beginners A1 - *Studies outline*



Being able to read Greek alphabet is the only requirement for registration in the Beginners A1 group.

The course consists of 23 lessons and each one lasts 1 hour and 30 minutes

This schedule is just a plan. It does not mean that we will cover everything or we will not cover anything else that might interest our students. A group lesson is very dynamic and the pace of the lessons and the exact topics we will cover depends on the students.



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Lesson 1

First meeting. The tutor and the students get to know each other.

1. Learning how to introduce ourselves and others to people orally (vocabulary of greetings and salutations. Πώς σε λένε; Με λένε ... Είμαι ο/η ... Καλημέρα, Καλησπέρα, Γεια, Γεια χαρά).
2. Grammar: Learn the difference between nominative and vocative when using proper names. The use the masculine definite article "ο" and the feminine "η" before proper names.

Lesson 2

1. Learning how to introduce myself and others to people by writing (Είμαι ο/η ...). Vocabulary of greetings and salutations (Πώς σε λένε; Με λένε ... Είμαι ο/η ... Καλημέρα, Καλησπέρα, Γεια σου, τί κάνεις;).
2. The verb είμαι; the personal pronoun (in nominative); affirmation and negation.

Lesson 3

1. I speak about myself and provide personal information to others (Από πού είσαι; Είμαι από ... / Πού μένεις; Μένω ...).
2. Nouns (masculine, feminine, neuter and their endings).
3. Vocabulary: Introductions and places.

Lesson 4

1. The use of prepositions από and σε with the accusative case.
2. Numbers 1-10.
3. I write and speak about myself.

Lesson 5

1. I talk about my family (Basic vocabulary about family members: μπαμπάς, μαμά, αδερφός, αδερφή).
2. How to describe a person (Vocabulary about description of physical appearance and character).

Lesson 6

1. Possessive pronouns in singular and plural.
2. Adjectives and their endings

Lesson 7

1. I learn the basic vocabulary about countries, nationalities and languages (vocabulary).
2. The verb μιλάω/μιλώ (grammar).
3. I speak and I write about myself and my family.

Lesson 8

Revision of lessons 1-7.

Lesson 9

1. I talk about how I like to spend my free time (vocabulary about hobbies).
2. Days, months, seasons and numbers (11-100).

Lesson 10

1. I learn to speak about my daily life and what I do everyday.
2. I learn to say the time in Greek.

Lesson 11

1. Pronunciation of letter Λλ
2. Subject and object and the use of the case in a sentence (nominative and accusative).

Lesson 12

1. Interrogative pronoun ποιος - ποια - ποιο/τι.
2. The verbs τρώω, έρχομαι, κοιμάμαι.
3. I write about my daily life.

Lesson 13

1. I read and learn about holidays and related vocabulary.
2. Numbers 100-1000.

Lesson 14

1. The verb μπορώ in the present tense.
2. Learning how the subjunctive mood is used in Greek.
3. Negation with subjunctive mood.

Lesson 15

1. Listening to and understanding how to organize excursions, book tickets and hotels, transportation and food.
2. Pronunciation of letter Xχ.

Lesson 16

1. Ordinal numbers 1ος - 10ος.
2. Comparison of adjectives.
3. I learn how to book a room at a hotel and buy a bus ticket on the phone.
4. I write a holiday postcard.

Lesson 17

1. My home. I learn the basic vocabulary to describe my house and neighborhood.
2. Colors in Greek
3. I learn about the adjectives in the nominative and accusative case (singular and plural).

Lesson 18

1. Listening to and earning the basic vocabulary necessary for renting a house and how to describe your house (house rooms and objects).
2. Pronunciation of Kκ.

Lesson 19

1. The imperative mood.
2. I learn how to describe and rent a house orally.
3. I write a short paragraph describing my house.

Lesson 20

Revision of lessons 9-19

Lesson 21

1. Christmas season. I read how people celebrate Christmas and learn the basic vocabulary for this holiday. I also learn other holidays in Greece.
2. The future tense and how it is formed.

Lesson 22

1. I learn how to interact in a clothing shop (vocabulary of clothes and shops).
2. Listen and learn how to pronounce words with “f” and “v” sound.
3. Personal pronouns in the accusative case and demonstrative pronouns (αυτός/εκείνος).

Lesson 23

1. I practise my speaking skills in a clothing shop.
2. I write a party invitation.

Lesson 24

1. I learn how to interact in a grocery shop and a supermarket (vocabulary of food).
2. At Laiki agora”. I learn how to shop in an open market.
3. Talk about recipes.

Lesson 25

1. Indefinite pronouns and how to use them (για, χωρίς από).
2. Interrogative pronoun and how to use them (πόσος, πόση, πόσο).
3. Adjective (πολύς, πολλή, πολύ).

Lesson 26

1. Vocabulary: Professions.
2. I talk about my profession (hours, days off, holidays, salary).
3. Job interview.

Lesson 27

1. Past tense .
2. I talk about my last holiday, what I did last week, last weekend etc.

Lesson 28

1. Vocabulary: my body, how to say i am sick and what kind of problem I have , medicine.
2. To the doctor: role play.

Lesson 29

1. Revision of lessons 19-29.

Lesson 30

1. To the pharmacy, to the doctor.
2. Advice a sick person (what to do to get better).
3. Interrogative pronoun (ποιανού, ποιανής, ποιονού) and how to reply.

Lesson 31

1. Vocabulary related to bank and the post office.
2. To the bank and to the post office (role play).
3. Services: police, fire brigade, electricity, water supply company etc.
